MT Metro Track: Protect Your Vehicle

The Aurora Police Department has launched a new auto-theft prevention program called MetroTrack which provides community members with a free GPS tracking device to help recover their vehicle if it's ever stolen. Aurora community members may receive up to two free tracking devices per household. Participation is completely voluntary, and at no time can the Aurora Police Department access a vehicle's location without the owner's consent.

To learn more and register for the program, visit: AuroraGov.org/MetroTrack. Note: current vehicle registration and car insurance are required to receive free GPS tracking devices. Please share this resource widely among your friends, family, and neighbors.

How to sign up for MetroTrack:

Visit AuroraGov.org/MetroTrack or scan the QR code to complete the online registration form. After registering, return to AuroraGov.org/MetroTrack to select a date and time to visit APD District 1 (13347 E. Montview Blvd., Aurora, CO) to pick up your free Bluetooth tracking device and MetroTrack materials.
