



## **Landscape Committee**

The Landscape Committee has been developing plans for our community focusing on landscape symmetry. We are creating a plant schematic utilizing many of the existing plant choices you see around the pool and on the newly planted slopes. We have several efforts in the planning phase including reimagining the monument signage to establish a grand entrance to Kite Hill. Overtime, this will include enhancing the visual beauty of roughly 50 feet on either side of the monuments. We will also look to visually enhance the monument at Recreational Center Drive and Kite Hill Drive.

Ongoing efforts will continue throughout the community and on Alicia Parkway to manicure, clear, and replace overgrown/dead shrubs and trees. We are immediately replacing more than 20 trees that have previously been removed.

Our goal is to create thoughtful landscape schemes that create symmetry in the common areas while providing wonderful color and vibrancy to our beautiful Kite Hill Community.

MAINTENANCE: Home maintenance community wide helps to maintain and increase home values for all Kite Hill Homeowners. Please remember to maintain landscape and ensure exterior painting and repairs are completed. If you are ready to paint, please contact Seabreeze Management for an application.

COURTESY LETTERS: The Volunteer Rules Committee has been completing monthly community inspections and the results have been great. There are many new mailboxes, homes have been painted and landscape is looking better overall. **STORAGE:** Storage on driveways or in the view of the street is prohibited. This includes inoperable vehicles, trailers, and recreational vehicles covered or uncovered. Driveways must be clear at all times. Please do not store items in the front or on the side of your home in view of the common area. Also, please note that PODS or other temporary storage units are only permitted for a brief time period. If long term storage is need it must be done off-site.

## **Neighborhood Watch**

On June 27, the Laguna Niguel Police department hosted a meeting at the Crown Valley Park Community Center. Current crime trends were discussed including an uptick on residential burglaries. Most thieves leave houses in under 2 minutes. They usually target houses near green belts, trails or vegetation that's accessible from sidewalks. They steakout the homes in advance to get a pattern of when the homeowners won't be home. The police are using unmarked patrols, bike patrol by volunteer PAC members and flyovers by drones for heat signatures. It's not just Orange County that is seeing more burglaries, the problem is nationwide.

What the police do recommend for prevention is to get a protective film to put over any glass. The film makes it much harder to shatter. The burglars want a quick and easy target. Anything that the homeowner can do to make it harder will help deter them. While they didn't endorse any product that did mention 3m makes a product for shatter proof protection.

## **Gardening Club Article**

Hi KH Neighbors! August is a great month to harvest your garden fruits and vegetables. Tomatoes, beans, peas, cucumbers, onions and strawberries should all be at peak ripeness. It's important to harvest before fruits and vegetables get overripe or eaten by pests. This month you can start planting your second round of edible plants for a late-fall or winter harvest. It's best to wait until the end of the month, since this month tends to be quite hot and not an ideal time for planting. You can transplant tomatoes or peppers any time in the month.

You can also start cucumbers, celery, beans, and zucchini. Now is the perfect time to look back on your spring and summer crops to analyze what to plant for the rest of the year. What crops did best in different parts of your yard? Are there any plants that need a different amount of sun or water? Did
