The Tiffany Architectural Control Committee walk-thru will take place during the weekend of June 28. Please get your yards and houses ready and compliant with the HOA standards. The main variances we have noted over the last couple of years have been shrubs, branches, and trees growing into or hanging low over the sidewalks. Bare spots in lawns and weeds growing in the landscaped areas are also common things we must write notices for. Please get these things remedied <u>before</u> the walk-thru if at all possible!



# **HOA Dumpster Days**

This year the Tiffany HOA Dumpster Days will be June 29 & 30, 2024 (Saturday and Sunday). Four roll-off dumpsters will be placed around Tiffany.

The list below lists prohibited items. If these items are found, we have to remove the items, and there is an extra charge to Tiffany for additional pickup trip.

- Dirt, Rock, Brick, Concrete, Sod
- Appliances with freon (Refrigerators/Freezers)
- Tires, Paint, Oil
- Hazardous Materials/Chemicals
- Electronics (TVs/Monitors/Computers)

If we meet the dumpster restrictions, it still costs over \$2100 in HOA funds. Please do not tell anyone outside Tiffany about the dumpsters. We've had considerable problems in the past with outsiders dumping materials during early morning hours and on adjacent sidewalks and lawns.

Tiffany asks that large branches and yard waste be taken to the free Centennial mulch event location June 1st, 8 am to noon at 7100 S. Holly Street.

If you have bulky items that can be easily broken down (ie: plastic shelving), please do so before tossing them in the dumpster. The smaller pieces leave far more space for our neighbors to put their items in. The dumpsters have always been over-full for pick up, and a few people must repack them before the trash company will pick them up.

# CenCON 4/22/2024 Meeting Notes

Centennial Council of Neighborhoods. Tiffany is a member.

This meeting was held at the YMCA at Southglenn. The meeting in July will be held at Project C.U.R.E. which is a charity organization which started in Colorado in 1987 and serves to deliver medical supplies to low resource locations around the world. You can donate money or medical supplies. Check their website at https://projectcure.org. If you wish to donate physical items check the following guideline list at https://projectcure.org/app/uploads/2023/03/2023-Updated-Donation-guideline-listing.pdf and get the items to me and I will see they are delivered to Project Cure.

The Arapahoe County Commission District 3 Jeff Baker spoke of the upcoming 2025 significant budget shortfall. Inflation of expenditures is outpacing revenues from sales taxes and property taxes. The county will be asking for tax increases in November. If they don't get the money they will have to reduce services and postpone the building of new buildings. For reference, Tiffany is in District 1 and Kathleen Conti is our Commissioner.

Sheriff Lt. Burson reminded us that car thefts and property theft from unlocked cars goes up in the warmer months along with the migration of homelessness to expanded areas.

South Suburban Michelle Kitchens reminded us that Summer Catalog is out and that they are seeking summer teenage employment. If your high schooler needs summer work, please check with South Suburban.

Holly Whelan with the Arapahoe Library district reminded us of the summer reading program from July through October in which they will supply books to youth under the age of 18. Also, she told us of the free concert at Centennial Park on July 14th from 7 to 9. The band "That Eighties Band" will perform. They are

supposed to be very good. She told us in closing, that James Taylor will be at the Koelbel Library on June 2nd from 12 to 1. He is playing at Red Rocks the previous night and someone at the library knows him personally and was able to swing this. Go by and say "Hi".

Next month, the High Line Canal Conservancy will give a talk on the High Line Canal to CenCON.

# **Street Sweeping**


