The annual SouthPark HOA Board meeting will be held on Monday, Oct. 16, at 7:00 p.m. in the SouthPark 1 Clubhouse; check-in begins at 6:45 p.m. All residents are encouraged to attend this important meeting to learn more about 2024 plans and budgets, including HOA dues increases, and to vote on new board members. **We need your vote!** The Annual Meeting can only take place if a quorum is obtained, which means at least 10% (41) of owners entitled to vote must be present, in person or by proxy, to reach a quorum.

Annual Meeting packets, including the ballots for new Board members, were mailed to residents; unfortunately, there was an error in the first packet. A second, updated packet was mailed on Sept. 25. Please be sure to refer to the updated packet. If you're unable to attend the Annual Meeting in person, mail your ballot AND the proxy document to AMI with enough time for them to receive the documents by Oct. 13. Otherwise, bring your ballot to the Annual Meeting in person.

The updated Annual Meeting packet includes everything you need to vote, including the ballot and the proxy (which must be included with your ballot if you

are not attending the meeting in person), as well as the mailing address to return the ballot and proxy. The packet also includes the Annual Meeting agenda and the 2024 budget. This information was also emailed to all residents who've provided an email address to AMI. The Board looks forward to seeing a large turnout of residents at this important meeting on Oct. 16!

News From The Board

At this time we have two candidates for two open board positions. The Annual Meeting will be held on October 16 at 7:00 p.m.; check-in at 6:45 p.m. in the SouthPark 1 Clubhouse. AMI mailed the voting and meeting documents to SouthPark 1 residents in late September.

The 2024 SouthPark HOA budget has been approved. The Board passed a \$10 increase in monthly dues for single family homes, and an \$8.84 increase for townhomes. The change in dues was necessary to address increased annual operating costs and increased costs for reserve-related expenditures being contemplated for 2024. The new amounts, effective January 1, 2024, will be \$145 for single-family homes and \$218.84 for townhomes.

Open Forum: At the September HOA Board meeting, the Board fielded questions from residents about roof and skylight replacements related to July's hail storm. Please submit ACC requests for replacement of both the roof and/or skylights. Despite receiving many requests, ACC is able to grant approvals quickly when the necessary information is provided along with the request (i.e., pictures of existing roof and proposed roof replacement material). Please note that for the townhomes, ACC is trying to keep the style and color of roofing material consistent on buildings, despite having numerous shingle manufacturers and colors that aren't standard. When in doubt, please contact an ACC Committee member and obtain approval before starting your roof replacement!
