

## **New LPS District Stadium**

Thanks to LPS voters, a new district stadium is being built at the corner of Arapahoe Road and Colorado Boulevard. This new stadium will provide an additional lighted field and track with spectator seating for both school and community sports teams to use. The new stadium is part of a \$298M Bond passed by voters in November 2018.



The naming process follows Board Policy FF, Naming District Facilities. All LPS employees were given the opportunity to submit name ideas for the new district stadium. More than 100 names were submitted. District leaders narrowed the ideas to three for the Board's consideration: LPS Centennial Stadium, Rocky Mountain Stadium, and Alpine Stadium were presented to the Board

during its April 13, 2023 meeting. Subsequently, during the April 27, 2023 meeting, the Board voted unanimously for LPS Centennial Stadium. Board members noted that they value the close relationships they have with the Littleton and Centennial municipalities, and they were happy to demonstrate that value by including in the name of each LPS stadium the name of the city in which it is located.

The LPS Centennial Stadium is scheduled to be completed and open for use in the fall of 2023.


