2023 High School Graduates Apply Now For \$500 WHOA Scholarship

Members voted at the January general membership meeting to fund one \$500 scholarship for a student who graduated high school this year. The following requirements apply:

- The graduate must live in a household that is a member in good standing of WHOA (having paid membership dues for 2023);
- Graduate must have graduated high school in 2023;
- Graduate must be continuing his or her education. All forms of education, college, community college, trade school, apprenticeships, etc. are acceptable;
- To be eligible, a graduating senior must submit a one page essay on the topic: How I can positively impact my neighbors in Westbury, in Jefferson County, in Colorado, and in our great nation, what are my education plans and aspirations, and if I should be awarded the scholarship, how do I plan to use it.

Fourth of July Fireworks

The first fireworks were used as early as 200 BC. The tradition of setting off fireworks on the 4 of July began in Philadelphia on July 4, 1777, during the first organized celebration of Independence Day. Ship's cannons fired a 13-gun salute in honor of the 13 colonies. The Pennsylvania Evening Post reported: "at night there was a grand exhibition of fireworks (which began and concluded with thirteen rockets) on the Commons, and the city was beautifully illuminated." That same night, the Sons of Liberty set off fireworks over Boston Common.
