FALL BIRDING FESTIVAL AT BARR LAKE Barr Lake State Park, Brighton

(early-September)

LIVING HISTORY DAYS AT STAUNTON STATE PARK

(early-September)

Meet at the Group Picnic Area (10am-3pm) to view the local historic group's displays and try square dancing! From there, embark on a treasure hunt to find the Reynold's Gang's gold! The treasure hunt meanders through the historic Cabin District and ends at the original Staunton Cabin (35min. hike).
